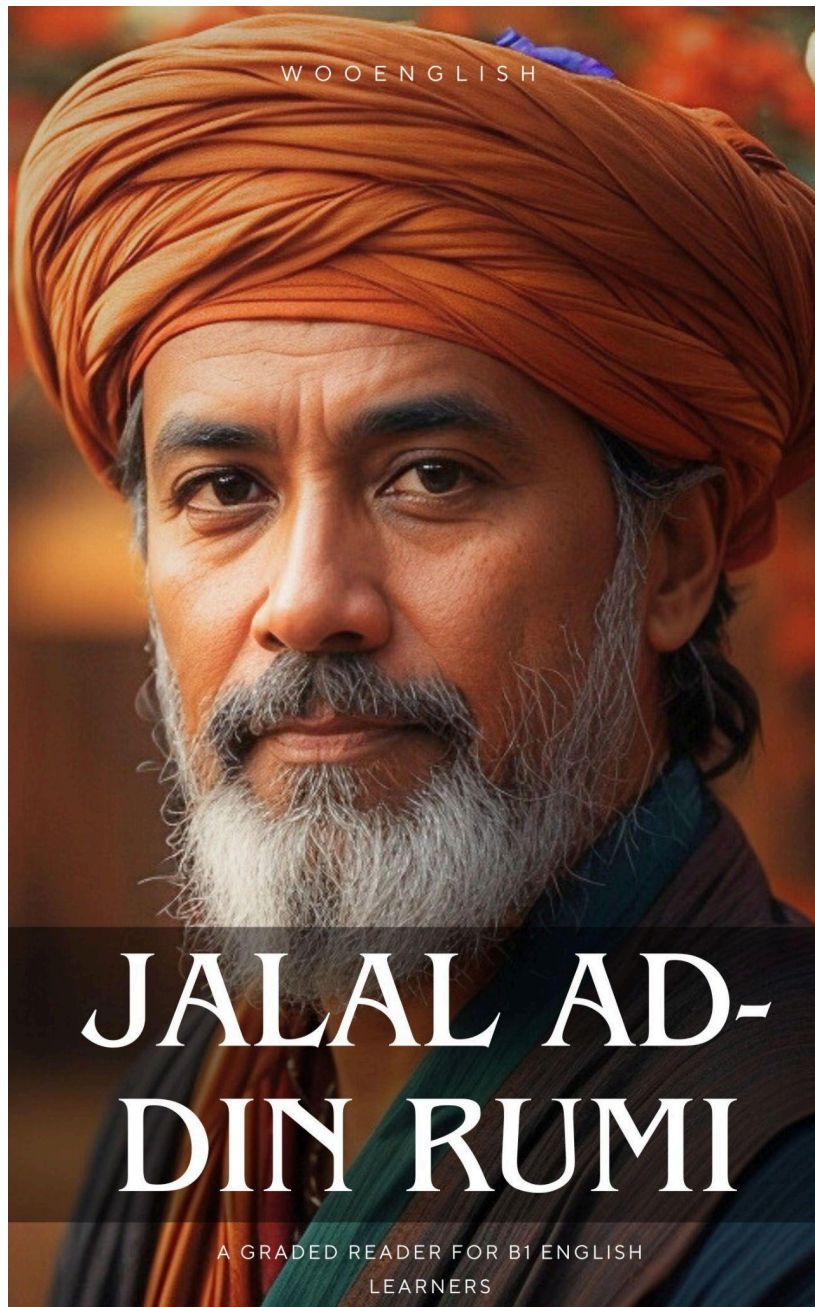




Jalal ad-Din Rumi
